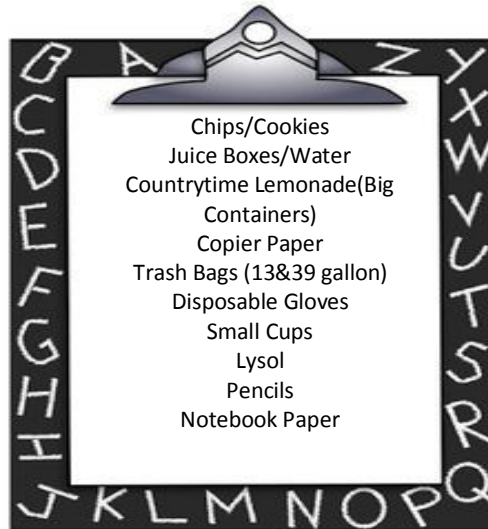
Commemorative Celebration
